The top line is the normal condensate line and it should have water flowing from this when the unit is running. If it is plugged, water would be coming out of the bottom pipe (Emergency Line). If that happens, we need to know about it to get the line unplugged. If it goes on for a while, it ends up staining our ceiling. Perry has labeled the outside pipes to help us.
